Dear Reader

This year at St Michael's Church, Bell Street Brierley Hill, we are hoping to hold our first ever 'Festival of Christmas Trees'. This is a wonderful way to bring our community together and we hope you will want to be a part of it.

The idea is that you loan us a tree (real or artificial), which is between 2'0" and 6'0" high and decorate it as you wish to reflect your activity. Novelty trees and humour (in keeping with the setting) is very much welcomed; but there will be a tree and cards available for people to write the name of a loved one on as a memorial tree. Your tree should have a firm base, and be stable as people will be moving round to view them. Lights are allowed on the trees but due to limited sockets we request that you use battery operated ones.

Trees can be installed Wednesday 4th December- 10am – 4pm and Thursday 5th December 12 midday

The Festival will start on Saturday 7th December when we shall also have our mini Christmas fayre, with coffee and mincepies and run until Sunday December 15th when we shall have our Carol Service in Church at 10.30am to which you are cordially invited. Days and times of opening during that week will be sent to participants and be on posters at church and in town later.

Trees can remain in place over the Christmas period, but will need to be removed on or by Saturday 28th December.

A name label will be made for your tree, but if you wish to place any other literature where it is displayed that is acceptable.

There is no charge for displaying your tree but adults visiting will be asked for a donation of £1.00. We hope to run a raffle during the week, if you feel able to donate a prize it will be gratefully received.

A programme detailing names of exhibitors will be available, with lists of exhibitors displayed in church.

We really would value your participation and hope you will feel able to contribute to this event. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to telephone Rev'd Beryl Pritchett on 01384 271470.
